GIZ provides the office for the Global Health Hub Germany. The data will be used exclusively for the purpose of providing information related to events and activities of the Global Health Hub Germany.

Responsible body for data processing is the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH.

The personal data provided as part of the registration (address and contact details incl. email address and telephone number), which are required for the purpose of the above-mentioned activities, will be stored at GIZ. The legal basis for the processing is the consent given in the declaration of consent for data processing on the registration page.

The data will only be used for the purposes described in the declaration; any other use will always be subject to renewed consent. Your data will not be used for advertising purposes.

GIZ secures the data by appropriate technical and organisational measures against accidental or intentional falsification, destruction, loss or access by unauthorised persons. Access to the personal data is restricted to those GIZ staff members (9 staff members within OU G110) who need to process this data in accordance with the above purpose(s) and handle it properly and confidentially.

The data will be provided to the Federal Ministry of Health (BMG).

## By agreeing to the declaration for data processing, members consent to:

- the use of their personal data (address and contact details incl. email address and telephone number) in the context of my membership of the Global Health Hub Germany.
- personal data (address and contact details incl. email address and telephone number) being stored by the Global Health Hub Germany for a further period of 2 years after the end of the purpose for which it was collected.
- GIZ is entitled to forward data (address and contact details incl. email address and telephone number) for contacting and information for future events and further activities of the Global Health Hub Germany to the following other organisations/agencies for further processing: Federal Ministry of Health (BMG). Before forwarding data to other persons or institutions outside GIZ and the aforementioned organisations/agencies - also in anonymised form - the respective person(s) responsible will personally contact the persons concerned.
- video and photographic recordings being made of them as part of their membership of the Global Health Hub Germany, which may be used in connection with the Hub's



activities, for the public relations work of GIZ and the Global Health Hub Germany (e.g. brochures, website). The recordings will not be used commercially.

 personal data being stored and used by GIZ in accordance with the declaration described above. This consent remains valid for a period of 2 years after registration as a member of the Hub.

## Data subject rights\_

You have the right to ask for your personal data, to have it corrected if necessary or to demand the restriction of processing or the deletion of the data. The data will then be deleted. You may also revoke your permission to use your personal data at any time. The lawfulness of the processing up to the time of the revocation is not affected by this.
