The following institutions and communities will be available for informal discussions during a **welcome coffee from 8:30 AM (registration opens) to 9:30 AM**:

1. Meet the Dutch Global Health Hub

- As the Netherlands' equivalent of the GHG, the hub brings together Dutch organisations working on the 3 priorities of the Dutch Global Health Strategy: (1) strengthening health systems (including SRHR), (2) improving pandemic preparedness and tackling cross-border health threats, and (3) addressing the impact of climate change on public health.
- *Come tell us what your organisation is working on, find your next Dutch collaborator, and let's strengthen global health together!*

2. Meet the European Union's Joint Action for Global Health Impact (JA GHI)

- Learn how JA GHI brings together a diverse range of partners from 24 European countries to strengthen regional collaboration and coordination to maximize impact of the EU Global Health Strategy.

- Join the conversation around the exhibition photos and video showcasing the public health impact of vaccines: *What stories, images, or messages do you think are most effective in demonstrating the value of investing in global immunization?*

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4. Travelling to Treatment Innovation with Drugs for Neglected Diseases initiative (DNDi)

- You will find out more about the activities of this Research & Development not-for-profit organization developing new treatments for the ones who need it most.
- Come visit and watch our new virtual reality short film that will make you travel to a village in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. It has been part of the development of a breakthrough treatment recently approved for sleeping sickness.

5. The Value of Global Health for Germany with the Global Health Policy Lab (GHPL)

- Together with colleagues, Michael Bayerlein from the GHPL analyzed the multidimensional value of Germany's global health engagement in a study for the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung.
- *In what ways does global health engagement benefit Germany? How could these benefits strengthen political commitment to global health?*
